Privacy Policy

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which came into force on May 25th, 2018, aims to protect the fundamental right to privacy and the protection of personal data of European Union (EU) citizens. This regulation affects any entity (including websites) that processes EU citizens' personal data.

Under GDPR, you have the right to:

- **information** about the processing of your personal data;
- **obtain access to** the personal data held about you;
- ask for incorrect, inaccurate or incomplete personal data to be **corrected**;
- request that personal data be erased when it's no longer needed or if processing it is unlawful;
- **object** to the processing of your personal data for marketing purposes or on grounds relating to your particular situation;
- request the **restriction** of the processing of your personal data in specific cases;
- receive your personal data in a machine-readable format and send it to another controller ('data portability');
- request that decisions based on **automated processing** concerning you or significantly affecting you and based on your personal data are made by natural persons, not only by computers. You also have the right in this case to express your point of view and to contest the decision.

Why do we collect personal information?

We collect such Non-personal and Personal Information for the following purposes:

- 1. To provide and operate our Services;
- 2. To provide our Users with on-going customer assistance and technical support;
- 3. To be able to contact our Visitors and Users with general or personalized service-related notices and promotional messages;
- 4. To create aggregated statistical data and other aggregated and/or inferred Non-personal Information, which we may use to provide and improve our respective services;
- 5. To comply with any applicable laws and regulations.

How do we store, use, share and disclose our site visitors' personal information?

The Dorset Police Male Voice Choir website is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to enable our services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. Your data is stored in secure servers behind a firewall.

The data we collect and store is adequate, relative and not excessive. We do not use, communicate or sell your data to 3rd parties.

How do we communicate with our site visitors?

<u>For Members</u>: we may contact you to notify you regarding your account, to troubleshoot problems with your account, to resolve a dispute, to collect fees or monies owed, to poll your opinions through surveys or questionnaires, to send updates about our choir, or as otherwise necessary to contact you to enforce our User Agreement, applicable national laws, and any agreement we may have with you. For these purposes we may contact you via email, telephone, text messages, and postal mail.

Anyone visiting our website can sign up to become a *Friend of the Choir* (consent) or download some of our tracks which requires your email address. This data may be used by us to send you marketing and promotional information on the choir's activities (for example emails about upcoming concerts).

We do not use, communicate or sell your data to 3rd parties.

All marketing material we send to you will include the option to 'opt out' of future emails ("unsubscribe").

How do we use cookies and other tracking tools?

There are two types of cookies:

Session (Transient) cookies: these cookies are erased when you close your browser, and do not collect information from your computer. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies: these cookies are stored on your hard drive until they expire (i.e. they are based on a set expiration date) or until you delete them. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as Web surfing behavior or user preferences for a specific site.
